**1. Rationale**

To announce Financial Institutions' Holidays for 2011.

**2. Statutory Authority**

By virtue of the provision of section 37 of Financial Institutions Business Act B.E.2551, the Bank of Thailand hereby announces financial institutions' holidays for 2011.

All financial institutions under Financial Institutions Business Act B.E.2551.

7. Monday	2 May	Substitution for National Labour Day (Sunday 1 May)
8. Thursday	5 May	Coronation Day
9. Tuesday	17 May	Wisakha Bucha Day
10. Friday	1 July	Mid Year Closing Day
11. Friday	15 July	Asarnha Bucha Day
12. Friday	12 August	H.M. the Queen's Birthday
13. Monday	24 October	Substitution for Chulalongkorn Day (Sunday 23 October)
14. Monday	5 December	H.M. the King's Birthday
15. Monday	12 December	Substitution for Constitution Day (Saturday 10 December)
