Summary Methodology <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analytical Framework, Concepts, Definitions, and Classifications • Scope of the data • Accounting Conventions • Nature of the Basic Data Sources • Compilation Practices 	<p>Employment indicators indicate the phenomena of domestic and international Labour market, comprising major Labour market statistics; namely, number of registered applicants, job vacancies, placements, termination of employment, number of overseas Thai workers, and inward remittances.</p> <p>Number of registered applicants, job vacancies, placements are based only on those contacting and receiving services from Department of Employment, Ministry of Labour.</p> <p>Insured Persons and Utilisation comprises of reported number of insured person (article 33) and number of utilisation in the case of unemployment.</p> <p>Data on Overseas Thai Workers comprises 2 series. Those from October 2002 onwards are based on information on registration and application for working overseas obtained from “online system” of The Department of Employment. Data prior to October 2002 are based on number of Thai workers passing through all immigration check-points throughout the country.</p> <p>Inward remittances are foreign exchange records (International Transaction Reporting System: ITRS). Since 1 April 2004, The Bank of Thailand (BOT) has changed the data submission method from hardcopy (F.T. reports) to electronic data set.</p>
