Definition of terms used in the survey is as follows:</p> <p>Unemployed persons is defined as persons with the age of 15 years and over who during the week in which the survey is conducted, do not work, have no job, business enterprise or farm of their own. Persons in this category include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Those who are looking for a job, applying for a job or waiting to be called to work during the past 30 days prior to the interview date; or 2. Those who are not looking for work during the past 30 days prior to the interview date, but are otherwise available for work during the 7 days prior to the interview date. <p>The reason for leaving a job are classified as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Closure of employer 2. End of the contract labour 3. Dismissed or made redundant 4. Resignation 5. Business shutdown or cease operation 6. The termination of employment contract 7. Others
