Data on international investment position are disseminated in millions of US dollars, revealing the components of external assets and liabilities position, which can be classified as follows :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Direct investment (abroad or into Thailand) 2. Portfolio investment (equity and debt securities) 3. Other investment (monetary authorities, general government, bank and other sectors) 4. Financial derivatives 5. Reserve assets
