Summary Methodology <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analytical Framework, Concepts, Definitions, and Classifications • Scope of the data • Accounting Conventions • Nature of the Basic Data Sources • Compilation Practices 	<p>Portfolio investment refers to transaction that involves buying and selling of equity securities, debt securities in form of bonds, notes, money market instruments with the exception of securities classified as direct investment and reserve assets.</p> <p>The table displays portfolio investment data of <u>ALL</u> sectors, categorized as “assets” and “liabilities”. Assets refer to Thai residents’ investment in foreign securities, classified by country of issuer. Liabilities refer to nonresidents’ investment in securities issued by Thai residents, classified by country of investor.</p> <p>Data are mainly obtained through International Transaction Reporting System (ITRS), then adjusted to reconcile with international investment position (IIP) survey, external debt survey, and data from Thai Financial Instrument Information Center (TFIIC). Conversion to US dollar equivalent is based on monthly New York closing average exchange rate. Data are then converted to Baht equivalent using monthly commercial bank average exchange rate.</p>
